Dear Fellow Congregants,

Each year, Temple Torat Emet publishes its Book of Remembrance to memorialize those in our hearts who have passed away. The Book is used as part of Yizkor Services throughout the year. We invite you to honor your departed loved one(s) in this way, while helping to support our synagogue's fundraising efforts.

To participate this year, you can choose to memorialize your loved one(s) on a dedicated page for \$136.00, or in a list under your name. In list form, your first entry is \$18.00, and each additional name is \$5.00. There is no charge per loved one's name when you dedicate a full page.

The book also includes a special "Bearing Witness" section honoring those who have fallen in defense of our country and Israel. For an additional \$10 above the cost of your list or your full page, you can add this distinction to your entry.

Finally, please consider participating in the Men's Club initiative to remember the children who died in the Shoah (Holocaust). We have attached a list of the names of a small portion of the 1.5 million children who perished before they could fulfill their potential. So far, we have adopted and remembered over 200 children. If there is a child or children in your family who perished in the Holocaust, who is not on the list, please feel free to submit their name(s) instead. Please add \$5 for each child you add to your list or full page. These names are not included with the dedicated full page price.
