High School Incentive Plan (“HIP”) Program

A unique curriculum that does not require students to have Judaic educational background to attend. Students are rewarded as they develop their Jewish knowledge and experiences. Thanks to the vision and support of Sheila and Marvin Horowitz, and a special education grant from the Temple Emet Foundation, we are pleased to once again offer the HIP Program for the 2022-2023 school year.

The virtual sessions were very successful last year, but we felt we still lacked the social aspect of getting together with our peers, so this year we are looking to put together a hybrid model blending the successes of each component. Classes will be held once a month virtually (following the format we utilized last year) and once class will be on site at Temple Torat Emet from 5:30 – 7:00pm with time for socializing.

HIP classes will be held several times a month on Monday evenings

HIP Participation Program incentives as follows:

1. Students will earn the following for each class they attend and participate in classroom discussions, attend required services and display proper classroom and virtual decorum:

1 st year	\$10.00 per class
2 nd year	\$11.00 per class
3 rd year	\$12.00 per class
4 th year	\$13.00 per class
5 th year	\$14.00 per class

*** A lesser amount may be awarded if all standards are not met and is contingent on funds on being available.**

2. Student must attend one special Shabbat service conducted by the students during each semester. A maximum of 50% of all earnings will be forfeited if a student is not present at the pre-scheduled services or make-up if applicable.
3. Students must conduct themselves with proper decorum, behavior and dress while in class or on a virtual class as per the discretion and evaluation of the faculty. Students may be expelled if their behavior is

determined to be disruptive or disrespectful to fellow students, faculty and guest speakers.

In order to receive the full stipend, the student **must** comply with **all** the requirements as outlined above. Mr. Greenberg and the Education Director will determine whether a student has successfully qualified for any of the aforementioned incentives.
